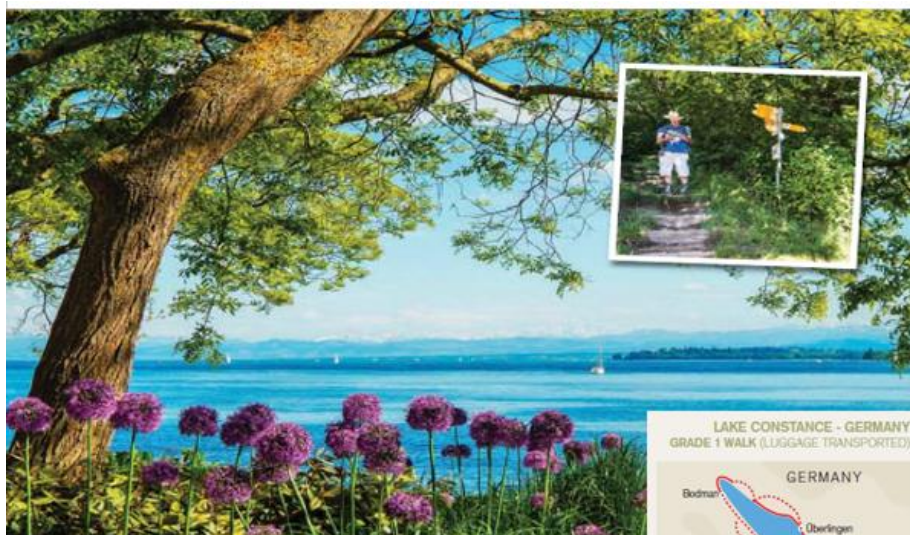

There's plenty to discover, too: gardens, churches and museums, plus stately towns whose prosperity reflects the importance of Lake Constance, just as its mirror-like waters reflect everything surrounding it. Linking all this is a network of boats, trains and buses, meaning you can do very little walking if you so wish, often free of charge thanks to the guest cards provided by each welcoming hotel. The abundance of apple trees – which blossom in early May – gives rise to pop-up fruit stalls along the trails, and such is the choice of restaurants that all stays are on a bed-and-breakfast basis. Be sure to try the delicious lake fish!



TAKE A DIP IN THE LAKE

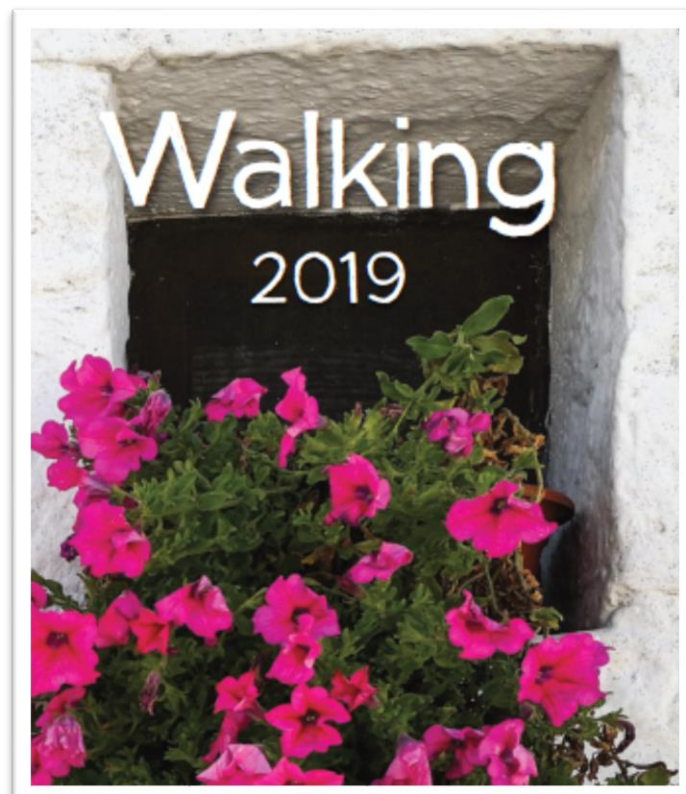
Your holiday begins with two nights at the modern, unpretentious Hotel Anker in Bodman, a village framed by wooded slopes in the lake's north-westernmost corner. There's no shortage of options for your first day. Stroll southwards along the leafy shores; take a boat or bus to Ludwigshafen and, after a leisurely lunch, walk back to Bodman through protected wetlands which are home to a variety of birdlife, or enjoy a swim from the small pebble beach.

THE GARDENS OF ÜBERLINGEN

The next day starts with a bus ride to Ludwigshafen, from where a short ascent brings you to a fabulous path which undulates gently through woodland, passing numerous vantage points looking right across the water towards the Alps. One even has a restaurant, an ideal lunch stop before the gentle descent into Sipplingen. From here you take the train to nearby Überlingen, for two nights at the elegant Hotel Villa Rosengarten, named after the adjoining rose gardens. You could take things easy the following day by exploring these and Überlingen's colourful parks (we provide a town trail) or by taking a boat to Unteruhldingen to visit the fascinating reconstructed still dwellings' museum. For some walking, we highly recommend returning to Sipplingen by train for a very varied route back to Überlingen via curious rock pillars and an open plateau.

Leaving Überlingen the next day, you catch the boat (included) to the floral island of Mainau. Stroll amid the mature trees and vibrant flowerbeds of its botanical gardens before following an easy lakeside path to eponymous Konstanz (or catch the bus). Here you spend a final two nights at the historic Barbarossa, giving you a full day to follow our town trail. Alternatively, you could take a boat to Friedrichshafen to visit its museum about the Zeppelin, the iconic 'flying cigar' which often drifts above the lake – or head to the monastic island of Reichenau for a gentle circuit amid market gardens and landmark churches.

An imposing lighthouse and two Bavarian lions stand guard at the entrance to the harbour, and there are memorable views across to the snow-covered Swiss Alps to enjoy. We then drive, or perhaps take a cruise, to Friedrichshafen, where the lakeside promenade is one of the longest on the lake. The fascinating Zeppelin Museum celebrates the story of Count Zeppelin. Look out for an impressive 33m-long reconstruction of the ill-fated Hindenburg airship.

Day 4

Austria – Free time in Feldkirch

Enjoy a leisurely day today with time to explore medieval Feldkirch with its well-preserved towers and picturesque bridges. Ducal houses offer an insight into the town's past and the Town Hall's frescoes portray

Day 5

Switzerland – Rorschach Boat, Bus and Train Excursion

We travel to Switzerland today and visit the charming town of Rorschach with its beautiful lakeside promenade and stately buildings. We highly recommend joining a boat for a cruise through the Altenrhein nature reserve to Rheineck. A rack and pinion railway then takes you up to the little village of Walzenhausen, nearly 900 feet above the lake. Enjoy the magnificent panoramic views stretching as far as the Vorarlberg and the nearby Alpstein area. It is only a short journey to Heiden by postbus, a beautiful little town with fantastic views over Lake Constance, before descending by mountain railway back to Rorschach. This excursion allows you to experience beautiful Swiss scenery all day. Alternatively, having explored Rorschach, enjoy a panoramic bus tour of the area, stopping here and there to take in the views.

Day 6

Liechtenstein – Vaduz

Today we drive the short distance into the tiny principality of Liechtenstein to visit the capital, Vaduz. The 700-year-old Vaduz Castle has been the palace and official residence of the Prince of Liechtenstein since 1712. Just 62 square miles in size, Liechtenstein is one of only two doubly landlocked countries in the world, and it is known for its postage stamps and excellent wines. Perhaps explore this charming capital with a guided city tour or relax at a wine tasting.

Day 7

Austria – Silvretta Alpine Road to St Anton

Enjoy a leisurely circular drive through the pearly white peaks of the Silvretta mountain range (toll payable locally). Travel through this dramatic landscape and take in magnificent views across to Piz Buin, Vorarlberg's highest peak. Spend the afternoon in the once sleepy and now charismatic St Anton. The idyllic village surrounded by luscious scenery and mountain peaks is a true dreamscape.

We take a passenger ferry for the 20-minute crossing to Mainau, the Island of Flowers. This tropical paradise is still owned by the noble Bernadotte family, the Swedish Royal family. We return to Meersburg to join our coach to return to the hotel.

Day 9-10

Return to the UK

It's time to leave Feldkirch and the beautiful Lake Constance and commence your return journey back to the UK. Make an overnight stop en route to Calais, where we take the ferry back to Dover and continue home.
