

Are you interested in the cult object Zeppelin and the pioneers of air navigation? How did they manage to build an airship that is almost four times as big as an Airbus but lighter than air? With more than 1,500 original exhibits as well as historical sound, film and image recordings, the collection in the Zeppelin Museum tells the story of airship travel vividly with multimedia content, captivating more than 250,000 international visitors each year. The highlight is the partial reconstruction of the LZ 129 Hindenburg. The Zeppelin Museum in the Bauhaus building of the harbor station also has a considerable art collection, which gathers the great masters from Southern Germany from the Middle Ages to modern times. Especially through its innovative temporary exhibitions, the Friedrichshafen Museum builds a bridge to contemporary art.

Giant flying boats, nostalgic passenger machines and exciting exhibits about space flight make the visit to the Dornier Museum Friedrichshafen at Lake Constance a matchless experience. Located closely to the airport, the museum presents an adventure world covering over 6,000 m². In addition to approximately 400 exhibits, plenty of original aircraft and replicas, such as the Dornier Wal and Dornier Merkur, bring the pioneer spirit of the past century to life.

On a guided tour of the museum, amusing anecdotes and interesting facts illustrate the development of the aviation industry and the pioneering achievements of engineer Claude Dornier. Countless world records, patents and technical achievements document the impressive history of the company Dornier. Political, economic and social conditions show what has moved and motivated people in the respective epochs.



Situated on the shores of Lake Constance, Schulmuseum Friedrichshafen offers an exciting journey through school history in Germany. The varied tour that holds plenty to discover, begins with the Middle Ages. Experience the show house, an authentic working class dwelling from the early 20th century, the inception of the Zeppelin industry, and part of the industrial workers' village "Zeppelinlindorf". Step into meticulously reconstructed and authentically furnished living quarters from different eras, and learn more about the living conditions of a working-class family between 1914 and today. In the attic, a small exhibition illuminates connections between urban and industrial history, and gives insights to the private lives of the residents. The show house is an ideal addition to the exhibition on airship history and technology at the Zeppelin Museum.



TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF TOURIST INFORMATION FRIEDRICHSHAFEN FOR PROVIDING TOURIST SERVICES TO RESELLERS AND PRIVATE GROUPS

Dear Client,

The following provisions shall become, as far as effectively agreed, the content of the procurement agreement between you and Tourist-Information Friedrichshafen, hereinafter referred to as "TI-FN" from 1st July 2018. They supplement and complement the statutory provisions applicable to the procurement agreement. The term "customer" refers to individual clients as well as groups, companies, associations or institutions as contracting entities, unless otherwise indicated.

1. TI-FN's position, scope of these terms for agency services

- 1.1. These terms and conditions apply to tourism services in which TI-FN acts as intermediary in accordance with legal provisions, insofar as these terms are legally agreed with the customer.
- 1.2. These terms for agency services apply both to provision to customers, who as part of their commercial activities either individually market services from accommodation facilities, catering operators, tour guides or providers of other services or as responsible package tour organizers conduct package tours or otherwise render tourism services to final consumers in accordance with §§ 651 ff. BGB, as well as procurement for private groups of consumers, which conclude the procurement agreement and contracts with implementing institutions for a purpose which can be attributed neither to their commercial nor their independent occupation (consumer in the sense of § 13 BGB).
- 1.3. Pursuant to regulations in para. 1.1, these terms for agency services shall apply, in particular, to contracts concerning the following offers:

- a) Arranging and reserving accommodation
- b) Arranging and reserving hotel allotments for trade fairs, congresses and conventions
- c) Arranging guided city tours
- d) Arranging guides (e.g., bus service)
- e) Arranging charter ships
- f) Arranging entrance tickets

1.4. Insofar as TI-FN arranges a compilation of the main tourist service and ancillary services of the brokered service providers (e.g. accommodation and transport) and ancillary services of the service providers are an essential part of the main service, TI-FN merely has the position of an agency of the contract between the customer and the service provider. The same applies if the ancillary services of the service providers do not make a significant contribution to the total value of the service provider's service set-up and neither represent nor advertise as such an essential feature of the service combination of the service provider or TI-FN itself. Service providers within the meaning of these provisions are bus companies, tour guides, carriers, providers of cultural events, restaurants and other service providers.

1.5. The TI-FN has the position of a provider of related travel services, as far as the legal requirements of § 651w BGB (German Civil Code), the conditions for an offer of related travel services of TI-FN are present. Without prejudice to the obligations of TI-FN as a provider of related travel services (in particular, transfer of the statutory form and execution of customer deposit protection in the event of debt collection by TI-FN) and the legal consequences of non-compliance with these legal obligations, TI-FN shall be responsible for the event if the prerequisites according to 1.4 or 1.5 are met, neither the tour operator nor the contracting party of the contract concluded with the mediated service provider in the booking. Therefore, the TI-FN is not liable for the details provided by the service provider regarding prices and services, for the provision of services itself and for performance defects. Any liability of TI-FN under the agency contract and statutory provisions, in particular mandatory provisions on teleservices and electronic commerce, shall remain unaffected.

2. Contract conclusion, applicable law

2.1. Conclusion of the procurement agreement does not require any specific form. Upon issuing the accommodation order, the procurement agreement is concluded between the customer and TI-FN as a management services contract.

2.2. If the order is placed electronically (e-mail, Internet), TI-FN shall immediately confirm receipt electronically. This acknowledgement of receipt does not confirm acceptance of the order.

2.3. The rights and obligations of the customer and TI-FN result, insofar as no compulsory statutory provisions conflict, on both sides from agreements made in the individual case (in particular regarding the nature and extent of the procurement agreement), its conditions and the statutory provisions of §§ 675, 631 ff. of the German Civil Code (BGB) regarding paid management services.

2.4. TI-FN points out that, in accordance with the legal provisions (§§ 312 (2), 4, 312g, paragraph 2, sentence 1, point 9 of the German Civil Code BGB), for agreements regarding recreational activities even when the contract partner is consumer and this has been concluded in remote sales (e.g., letters, catalogues, telephone calls, telecopies, e-mails, messages sent via mobile telephony as well as radio and telemedia), there is no right of revocation, but only statutory withdrawal and termination rights. There is, however, a right of revocation if the contract has been concluded for recreational activities away from the business premises, unless the oral proceedings on which the contract is concluded have led to the prior appointment of the consumer. In the latter case there is also no right of revocation.

3. Information, advice

3.1. By distributing instructions and information, TI-FN shall be liable for correctly selecting the information source and properly transferring it to the customer in accordance with the law and the contractual agreements.

3.2. For the correctness of the information result, TI-FN shall be liable in accordance with § 676 BGB, unless a special information contract has been concluded.

3.3. Within the scope of its mediation activity, TI-FN is not obligated to furnish the least expensive provider of the required service without express agreement.

3.4. TI-FN shall not be liable for information provided by service providers regarding the content and scope of services, prices and other circumstances of their business and services.

4. Remuneration, reimbursement of expenses, collection, payments

4.1. Unless otherwise agreed in individual cases, TI-FN's agency activity is free of charge for customers. However, TI-FN may demand compensation for expenses incurred for arrangements in so far as it has been agreed upon or if it could reasonably be considered necessary to do so.

4.2. In the case of arranged services, their total price shall be paid to the mediating service provider after confirmation of booking, unless otherwise agreed.

4.3. Insofar as the arranged services are connected travel services in accordance with § 651w BGB in the version from 01.07.2018, the following applies: TI-FN may only accept payments from the customer for travel services if it has ensured that this is reimbursed to the customer as far as travel services are to be provided by TI-FN itself, or compensation claims of intermediary service providers are yet to be fulfilled, and in the event of insolvency of TI-FN as intermediaries of connected travel services a) travel services fail or

b) the customer, in regards to services provided, complies with the payment requests of unsatisfied mediated service providers. This guarantee is provided by TI-FN in arranging connected travel services by taking out a bankruptcy insurance acc. § 651w Abs. 3 BGB, naming the contact details of the customer money saver in a clear, understandable and highlighted manner and delivery of a corresponding security certificate for all payments by the customer to the intermediary of connected travel services, as far as the customer is not directly providing to the mediated service provider of connected travel service.

5. Termination or rescission of the contract with commercial customers

5.1. If a commercial client, resigns, the following is applicable on behalf of the respective service providers arranged:

a) Withdrawal from the contract concluded with the service provider through TI-FN's intermediation is, unless otherwise expressly agreed in writing, fundamentally excluded.

b) In particular, unless otherwise expressly agreed, partial withdrawal or partial termination of individual services as well as rescission after general commercial use shall be excluded.

c) Therefore, the commercial client remains obligated to make full payment, unless otherwise agreed. The service provider only has to allow for expenses saved, or a different use of the booked service.

d) If accommodation services are the object of the contract, the saved expenses are fixed so that the commercial client has to make the following payments:

- For overnight stay without board 90 %
- For overnight stay with breakfast 80 %
- For overnight stay with half board 70 %
- For overnight stay with full board 60 %

of the total price, including all ancillary services, provided that it is reserved for the commercial client to prove to the accommodation company that the saved expenses were higher or that a different use of the agreed accommodation quotas occurred.

5.2. After commencing the contract, termination by the commercial client is only possible if there are significant deficiencies in or other disturbances of the service on the part of the responsible service provider. In these cases, termination is only permissible after an appropriate deadline for eliminating the defect or fault.

5.3. The service provider is entitled to withdraw from or terminate the contract in the following cases:

- a) If the provision of services becomes impossible for reasons beyond its control.

b) In the case of significant contractual violations by the commercial client or its participants against obligations under this contract or against the service provider's interests.

c) If advance payment or remittance after reminder and deadline is not received by the service provider as agreed and in due time.

6. Termination or rescission of the contract with consumer groups

6.1. The customer, who is the consumer, can withdraw from the contract at any time by declaration in writing before the date agreed for the service.

6.2. Cancellation shall take effect on the day on which the cancellation notice is received by the service provider or TI-FN.

6.3. If the customer withdraws from the agreement with the service provider or if he does not claim benefits without a withdrawal declaration, in particular due to non-performance reports, TI-FN or the service provider may charge compensation for preparations and associated expenses according to the agreed conditions for rescission or cancellation. Calculating the compensation usually takes into account possible other uses of the service as well as expenses that are usually saved.

6.4. Unless otherwise stipulated, the following cancellation costs with the respective service providers shall be agreed upon:

- a) If the object of the contract is the provision of accommodation services, the expenses incurred are fixed so that the customer has to make the following payments:
- For overnight stay without board 90 %
- For overnight stay with breakfast 80 %
- For overnight stay with half board 70 %
- For overnight stay with full board 60 %

of the total price, including all ancillary services, provided that the customer is entitled to prove to the accommodation company that the saved expenses were higher or a different use of the agreed accommodation quotas took place.

b) If the subject of the arranged agreement is other than services, the following cancellation fees are due:

- Up to 21 days before the date: no cancellation fees
- Up to 7 days before the date: 30% of the agreed price
- Up to 2 days before the date: 60% of the agreed price
- Afterwards or in case of non-appearance: 90% of the agreed price.

If more favourable cancellation fees have been agreed with the client for guided tours, these shall apply.

6.5. The customer shall not be obliged to prove to TI-FN or the service provider that the cancellation has resulted in no or less costs than the cancellation fees claimed. In the latter case, TI-FN is obliged to pay the lower costs.

6.6. Instead of a lump sum compensation (see section 6.4. b) the beneficiary or TI-FN can claim the actual costs as damages according to the statutory provisions. In this case, it is obligatory to quantify and document the expenses for the customer.

6.7. If TI-FN has arranged on behalf of customer services of other service providers (e.g., admission tickets) and these are not used due to customer's cancellation or non-approval, there is no customer claim for reimbursement against TI-FN. Costs are reimbursed by TI-FN only insofar as the service providers have actually reimbursed them to TI-FN. Any further claims, which are expressly reserved to the customer, shall be asserted directly to the service provider by the customer.

7. TI-FN's liability

7.1. Insofar as TI-FN has not assumed a corresponding contractual obligation by express agreement with the customer, it shall not be liable for concluding contracts corresponding to the customer's request for booking with intermediary service providers.

7.2. Without express agreement or assurance, TI-FN shall not be liable for any deficiencies in the performance and personal injury or material damage incurred by customer in connection with the travel service provided.

7.3. Any liability of TI-FN arising from the culpable violation of intermediary obligations shall remain unaffected by the above provisions.

7.4. The liability of the intermediary according to § 651w para. 4 BGB and § 651x BGB shall remain unaffected by the above regulations.

8. Alternative dispute resolution; law and jurisdiction

8.1. TI-FN points out with regard to the law on consumer conflict resolution that it does not participate in voluntary consumer dispute settlement. Insofar as a consumer conflict resolution would become obligatory for TI-FN after these terms and conditions are printed, TI-FN will inform consumer of this in an appropriate form. TI-FN refers to the European online dispute settlement platform <http://ec.europa.eu/consumers/odr/> for all contracts concluded in electronic legal transactions.

8.2. German law applies exclusively to the entire legal and contractual relationship between customer and TI-FN. Customer may only sue TI-FN at its registered office.

8.3. The customer's domicile shall be decisive for TI-FN's claims against the customer. For legal actions against clients who are merchants, i.e. legal persons of public or private right or persons who are domiciled or ordinarily reside abroad or whose domicile or habitual residence is not known at the time of bringing the action, the place of jurisdiction shall be TI-FN's place of jurisdiction.

8.4. The above provisions do not apply.

a) If and to the extent the provisions of international agreements applicable to the travel agency contract between customer and TI-FN are not contractually applicable

b) If and to the extent that the provisions applicable to the travel agency contract, which are not applicable in the EU
