Its sparkling waters shimmer in every shade of blue and green, framed by dramatic Alpine peaks, creating the perfect setting for year-round getaways.

Culture, Heritage, and Adventure

Lake Constance is a paradise for food lovers. Savor freshly caught whitefish, aromatic vegetables from UNESCO-protected [Reichenau Island](#), regional cheese fondue, and local Müller-Thurgau wine. Lakeside dining at sunset is an unforgettable experience.

Unwind in the region's renowned **thermal spas** in [Meersburg](#), [Constance](#), and [Überlingen](#). Indulge in massages, spa hopping, or natural moor baths. In [winter](#), the lake transforms into a serene escape featuring **skiing, Christmas markets, and the vibrant Alemannic Carnival**.

- **Panoramic [Zeppelin Flights](#) over Friedrichshafen:** See the region from above in a state-of-the-art airship, gliding over sparkling waters, vineyards, and the Alpine backdrop for an unforgettable perspective.

- **[Rhine Falls](#), Europe's Largest Waterfall:** Marvel at the Rhine as it plunges 75 feet, creating misty rainbows and breathtaking scenery. Explore observation decks, take boat trips, and visit nearby historic castles.

Getting there from US:

- **Flights:** Major U.S. airports connect to **Zurich** and **Munich**. Zurich is only one hour by train to Constance or St. Gallen.
- **Trains:** Efficient German and Swiss rail networks make it easy to reach towns around the lake.
- **Ferries:** Regular passenger ferries connect lakeside towns, offering scenic and leisurely travel.

The heart of Europe, one lake, four countries. The Lake Constance region, lovingly called ‘Bodensee’ by local residents, borders Germany, Austria, Switzerland and is just a short hop from the Principality of Liechtenstein.
